We're thrilled to announce that after 20 months of virtual programming, 12 chapters are returning to senior homes in-person this fall! We are following each senior home's guidelines, as well as local and state regulations to ensure a safe return to our signature program of manicures. Those chapters not yet returning in person are still participating in virtual programming.

NEW CHAPTERS
